Leave the M23 at Junction 11 and follow signs to Pease Pottage and Services. At the roundabout take the third exit, over the fly-over into Pease Pottage. Follow this road for about a mile and Cottesmore is on the right-hand side.

By rail

Crawley and three bridges are the nearest railway stations to Cottesmore and are on the London to Brighton mainline with regular trains to and from London. The stations are approximately a 10-minute taxi ride to Cottesmore.

- **Trousers must be full length or TAILORED Shorts and Neat Cargo Shorts can be worn to the knee. NOT BELOW**
- **Golf Shoes must be worn at all times by golfers. Flat shoes must be worn by caddies and spectators at their own risk.**
